

# We Are A “One Another” People

## The Foundation of Love

### *Love one another*

**Jn 13:34**—A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.

**Jn 13:35**—By this shall all *men* know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.

**Jn 15:12**—This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you.

**1 Jn 3:11**—For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.

**1 Jn 3:23**—And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.

**1 Jn 4:7**—Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God.

**1 Jn 4:11**—Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another.

**1 Jn 4:12**—No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.

**2 Jn 5**—And now I beseech thee, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment unto thee, but that which we had from the beginning, that we love one another.

**Ro 13:8**—Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.

**1 Th 3:12**—And the Lord make you to increase and abound in love one toward another, and toward all *men*, even as we *do* toward you.

**1 Th 4:9**—But as touching brotherly love ye need not that I write unto you: for ye yourselves are taught of God to love one another.

**1 Pe 1:22**—Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, *see that ye* love one another with a pure heart fervently.

### *4. Preferring one another*

**Ro 12:10**—*Be* kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another.

### *5. Be of the same mind toward one another*

**Ro 12:16**—*Be* of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.

**Ro 15:5**—Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus.

### *6. Edify one another*

**Ro 14:19**—Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another.

**1 Th 5:11**—Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do.

### *7. Receive one another*

**Ro 15:7**—Wherefore receive ye one another, as Christ also received us to the glory of God.

### *8. Admonish one another*

**Ro 15:14**—And I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another.

### *9. Greet (salute) one another*

**Ro 16:16**—Salute one another with an holy kiss. The churches of Christ salute you.

**1 Co 16:20**—All the brethren greet you. Greet ye one another with an holy kiss.

**2 Co 13:12**—Greet one another with an holy kiss.

**1 Pe 5:14**—Greet ye one another with a kiss of charity. Peace *be* with you all that are in Christ Jesus. Amen.

### *10. Tarry for one another*

**1 Co 11:33**—Wherefore, my brethren, when ye come together to eat, tarry one for another.

### *11. Have the same care for one another*

**1 Co 12:25**—That there should be no schism in the body; but *that* the members should have the same care one for another.

### *12. Serve one another*

**Ga 5:13**—For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only *use* not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.

### *13. Forbearing one another*

**Eph 4:2**—With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love.

**Col 3:13**—Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also *do* ye.

## One Another Verses

### *1. Have peace with one another*

**Mk 9:50**—Salt *is* good: but if the salt have lost his saltness, wherewith will ye season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace one with another.

### *2. We are members one of another*

**Ro 12:5**—So we, *being* many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.

**Eph 4:25**—Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.

### *3. Be kindly affectioned*

**Ro 12:10**—*Be* kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another.

14. *Be kind one to another (tenderhearted)*

**Eph 4:32**—And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

15. *Forgive one another*

**Eph 4:32**—And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

**Col 3:13**—Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also *do ye*.

16. *Submit to one another*

**Eph 5:21**—Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.

**1 Pe 5:5**—Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all *of you* be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.

17. *Teach and admonish one another*

**Col 3:16**—Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

18. *Comfort one another*

**1 Th 4:18**—Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

19. *Exhort one another*

**Heb 3:13**—But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

**Heb 10:25**—Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some *is*; but exhorting *one another*: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

20. *Consider one another*

**Heb 10:24**—And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

21. *Confess your faults one to another*

**Jas 5:16**—Confess *your* faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

22. *Pray one for another*

**Jas 5:16**—Confess *your* faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

23. *Have compassion one of another*

**1 Pe 3:8**—Finally, *be ye* all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, *be* pitiful, *be* courteous.

24. *Use hospitality one to another*

**1 Pe 4:9**—Use hospitality one to another without grudging.

25. *Minister your gifts one to another*

**1 Pe 4:10**—As every man hath received the gift, *even so* minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

26. *We have fellowship one with another*

**1 Jn 1:7**—But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

## Negative One Anothers

1. *Do not judge one another*

**Ro 14:13**—Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumbling block or an occasion to fall in *his* brother's way.

2. *Do not be puffed up for one against another*

**1 Co 4:6**—And these things, brethren, I have in a figure transferred to myself and *to* Apollos for your sakes; that ye might learn in us not to think *of men* above that which is written, that no one of you be puffed up for one against another.

3. *Do not go to law with one another*

**Co 6:7**—Now therefore there is utterly a fault among you, because ye go to law one with another. Why do ye not rather take wrong? why do ye not rather *suffer yourselves* to be defrauded?

4. *Do not bite and devour one another*

**Ga 5:15**—But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another.

5. *Do not lie to one another*

**Col 3:9**—Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;

6. *Do not be partial to one another*

**1 Ti 5:21**—I charge *thee* before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, and the elect angels, that thou observe these things without preferring one before another, doing nothing by partiality.

7. *Do not speak evil of one another*

**Jas 4:11**—Speak not evil one of another, brethren. He that speaketh evil of *his* brother, and judgeth his brother, speaketh evil of the law, and judgeth the law: but if thou judge the law, thou art not a doer of the law, but a judge.

8. *Do not grudge one another*

**Jas 5:9**—Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest ye be condemned: behold, the judge standeth before the door.
